In accordance with Federal regulations effective July 1, 2011, Granite State College (GSC) must provide funds for Federal Pell Grant eligible students to obtain books and supplies by the seventh day of the term.

Student Accounts will disburse funds ten days prior to the start of each term for Pell eligible students who are:

1. Awarded federal aid at the time of review; and
2. Have a credit balance on their account after direct charges (tuition and fees) are covered.

Checks, in the amount of the average cost of books and supplies (\$150 per 4 credit course), will be issued and mailed on the Tuesday prior to the term start. *Any scheduled holiday will delay the process to the subsequent day.*

GSC will only identify eligible students on the tenth day before the start of the term; and students will not be reviewed again for credit increases and decreases which may occur during the official add/drop period of each term. *Students who have a previous account balance are not eligible for review.*

If all coursework is dropped for the term after the release date of the funds, then the student is responsible for repayment to GSC within ten business days.

Opt out of Advanced Funds for Books and Supplies

Pell eligible students have the right to opt out of the advance payment process for books and supplies each term.
