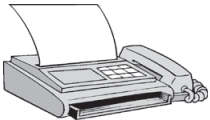

Registration Policy

Participants making any changes in class registration must do so by contacting the E&TP at 271-6625.

A **Drop Course (DC)** is a cancellation of an individual registration. Participants must contact the E&TP to officially drop a course. **Not attending classes does not constitute an automatic drop.** Officially dropped courses are not recorded on a record of training. Once a class has begun, those who wish to drop a course must do so **before the second class session or during the first week of distance learning course.**

Participants who do not comply with this registration policy will receive a **No Pass (NP)** on their E&TP record of training.
