NOTES:

- 1 NOTE: One key component in declining credit hour counts is reduced section counts, reflecting several years of consolidating demand from across the state by expanding offerings of Online courses. Class sizes in online courses average 1.5 times that of Center-based courses. Another factor in reduced section counts is the conversion of low-enrolled Center-based courses (many of which would have been cancelled in earlier Fiscal Years) into faculty-mentored Individual Learning Contracts (ILCs). ILC credit hours are not included here, but have increased from 1,305 in FY2002 to 2,145 in FY2006.
- 2 A steep decline in demand due to a downturn in IT-related industries has resulted in the steady reduction of CMPL credit hours.
- 3 There have been numerous curriculum changes, including creation of new departments and course shifting. Examples (heavy boxes) include 1) COMM (Communications) and ENG (English)—many English courses were formerly COMM or HUMN courses, but they are now in their own department; 2) ECHD (Early Childhood), EDU, and INST (Instructional Design) courses—FY 2006 saw only one INST course, but there are several running in FY 2007; and 3) HIS (History) and HUMN—History courses now have their own department designation.
