2010 – 11 Student Services Calendar

**Summer 2010**

**May 28**

Registration for the term begins. Register online, by mail, fax, phone or in person.

**July 1**

Online registration closes. Registration continues by mail, fax, phone or in person.

**PAYMENT DUE DATE – Friday, July 2**

Tuition payments or documented payment arrangements, (including financial aid), are due for all students registered prior to July 2<sup>nd</sup>.

Registrations on and after July 2<sup>nd</sup> require payment, documented payment arrangements, or completion of all financial aid documentation at time of registration.

\*\*\*Note\*\*\*: New degree candidates, or individuals applying for a subsequent degree, must have all admission and financial aid documentation in by Friday, July 2. ### **PAYMENT DUE DATE – September 3 (Friday of the Fifth week)**

Tuition payments or documented payment arrangements, (including financial aid), are due for all students registered prior to September 3<sup>rd</sup>.

Registrations on and after September 3<sup>rd</sup> require payment, documented payment arrangements, or completion of all financial aid documentation at time of registration.

Registrations on and after December 30<sup>th</sup> require payment, documented payment arrangements, or completion of all financial aid documentation at time of registration
