The following are updates to the 2019-2020 Graduate Studies Catalog. Effective November 2019. They are as follows:

➔ **The following paragraph on Transcripts (from the Graduate Studies catalog, page 82) has been updated. The change is in bold and italic text.**

### TRANSCRIPTS

Master's Degree candidates must ensure that all official previous college transcripts are received by the Graduate Admissions Office. Electronic transcripts are accepted from prior institutions that use 3rd party vendors for delivery. Electronic transcripts can be sent to [gsc.admissions@granite.edu](mailto:gsc.admissions@granite.edu). In order for a paper transcript to be "official" it must be in a sealed envelope from the college or university. Paper transcripts should be mailed to the Graduate Admissions Office, 25 Hall Street, Concord, NH 03301. Candidates who have earned a Bachelor's Degree from Granite State College do not need to request their official transcript(s). The Admissions Office will obtain the transcript(s) through the Registrar's Office. ***All application materials, including transcripts, become the property of Granite State College and will not be returned, duplicated, or forwarded.***
